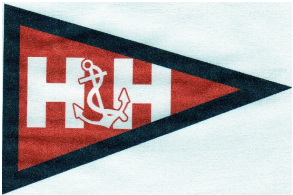
FROM THE PRESIDENT

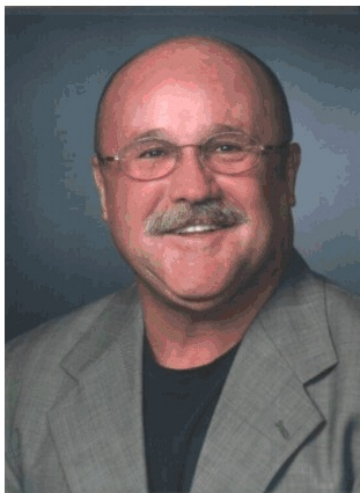

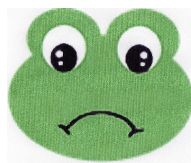
